Four years of learning

Freshman year

Junior

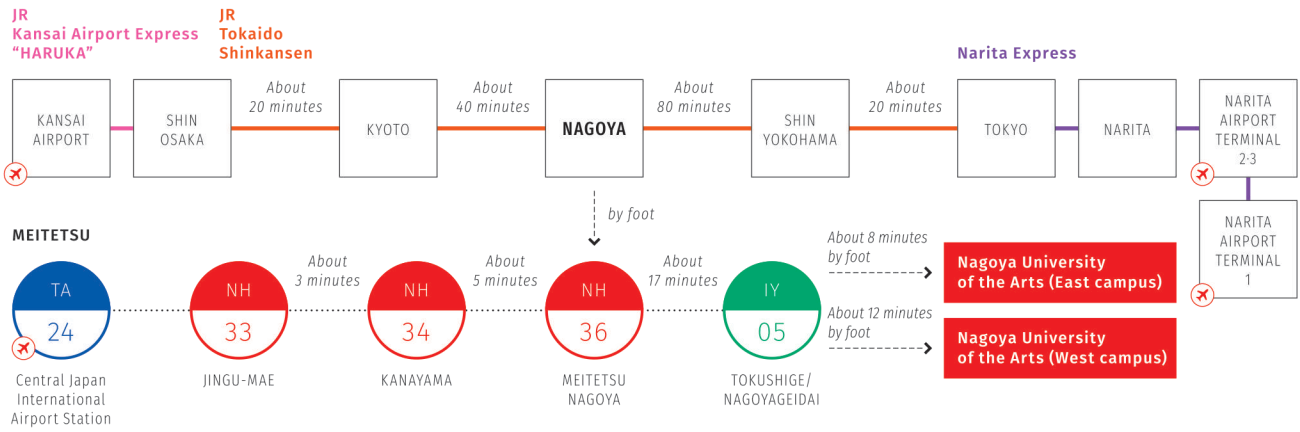

Access: The nearest station, "Tokushige-Nagoyageidai", has good access from Nagoya station (about 17minutes) and Central Japan International Airport station (about 50 minutes) by train. You can walk to each campus from the station in about 10 minutes.

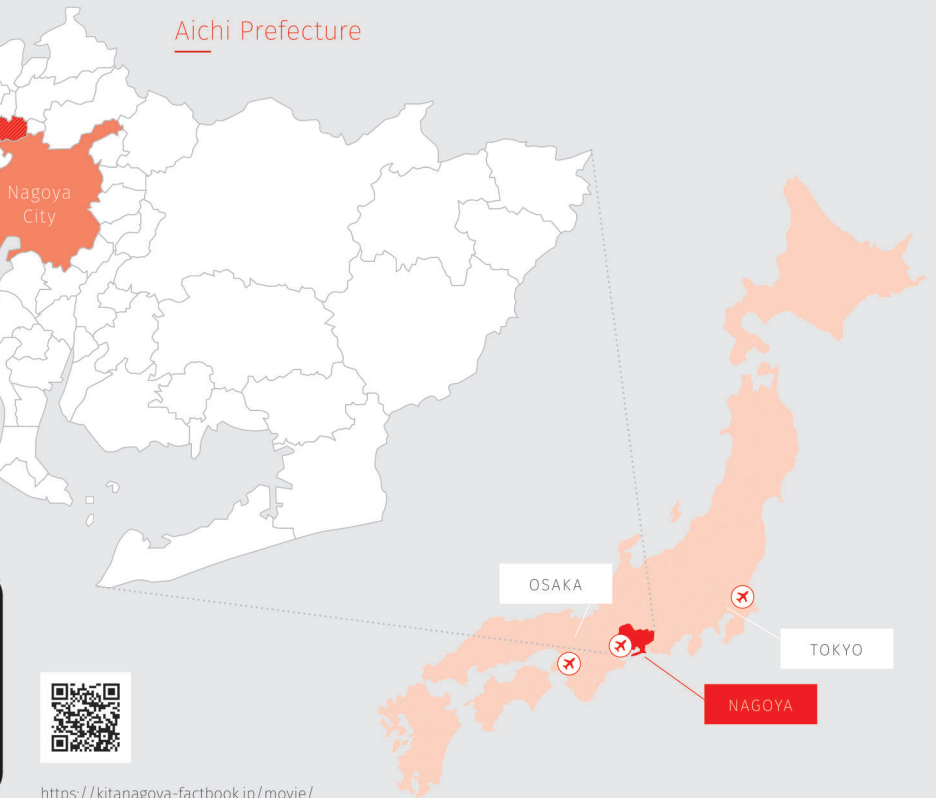
